

News 9/News on 6 – Republican Statewide Primary, 2014 June 19-21, 2014

Sample: Likely Republican voters in Oklahoma (n=840) using a frame of randomly selected landlines. Landlines were administered by IVR (Interactive Voice Response).

Margin of Error: $\pm 3.38\%$

Results weighted by age and Congressional district, then stratified using a model of previous primary elections.
