FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES which support probable cause to arrest the
Above named person are: _

On 02-23-2011 your affiant Investigator Lucky Miller with the District 24 Drug Task Force along with other Investigators from the District Attorneys office was driving on State Highway 48 to execute a search warrant at 4891 Spring Creek Road, Mannford Oklahoma, Creek County, A residence known as the Michael Hagar residence. Your affiant and Investigator Frank smith observed Michael Hagar pass us on Hwy 48. Your affiant followed Hagar until he pulled into a driveway near state Hwy 48 and Evans road in Creek County. Your affiant pulled into the driveway and made contact with Hagar who had already exited his vehicle and was walking to the residence. Your affiant and Inv. Smith made contact with Hagar and advised him that we had a search warrant for his residence. Your affiant told Hagar that we would transport him to his residence. Hagar consented to a search of his vehicle and your affiant located a plastic baggie containing a white powdery substance (weight with packaging 0.6 grams). The bag was found in a package of cigarettes that was located in the cup holder of the vehicle. A portion of the white powder was field tested and tested positive for methamphetamine. Hagar was transported to his residence where officers located the following individuals. 4 juvenile males located in the back yard and 3 adult males that were exiting a shed in the back yard area. The three adults were identified as Chelsea Gordon, Jacob Talley and Bryce Mitchell. Officers secured the subjects and started the search of the shed where the three males were coming out of. Officers located the following items associated with the manufacturing and use of methamphetamine. 1 lithium Battery casing, coffee filter containing a white powder residue, burn rubber gloves, burnt bottle of sodium Hydroxide, 3 cornered out plastic baggies, 1 empty salt container, and 1 wooden marijuana pipe. These items were located in a wood burning stove. Officers also located a Remington .22 rifle, blue funnel containing a white powdery residue and 1 peanut container containing white powdery substance. Officers searched the second shed which was located in the back yard. Officers found 2 empty blister packs and a bottle of Acid. Officers observed a trail leading from the shed into woods. Officers followed the trail for approximately 40 yards. Officers

located a junk pile located on the north side of the trail. Your affiant observed a milk crate and a black plastic case on the east side of the junk pile. Officers located the following items associated with the manufacturing of methamphetamine inside these two containers. 1, 16 oz bottle containing a bilayer liquid about ¾ full. Officers identified the bottle and contents as a used shake and bake meth cook, 1 bottle of drain opener ¾ full, house hold drain cleaner, sodium hydroxide full, 1 white bottle containing a white granular substance, 1 hydrogen chloride generator, 2 cans Coleman camp fuel 1 empty 1 ¾ full, 2 pipes, set of digital scales, 1 jar with a white powdery residue a portion was field tested and tested positive for methamphetamine, coffee grinder containing a white powder residue, 1 yellow marijuana grinder, blue zipper bag containing jeweler baggies, brown zipper bag with unused coffee filter and cut off straws, blue zipper bag containing rubber gloves, Crown Royal bag containing a glass pipe and straws, red funnel containing a white powdery residue, 1 measuring cup containing a white granule sludge and black case containing swabs and 2 syringes.

Officers searched the residence and located the following items. Tulsa County Deputy badge, 2 metal smoking pipes, 1 metal spoon containing residue, 1 wooden pinch hitter containing a burnt green leafy residue, 1 home made light bulb pipe, 1 set of digital scales, 1 sawed off shotgun .20 gauge. These items were located in the master bedroom. Items located in the juvenile male's room are as follows. 4 glass meth pipes containing a white powdery residue, 1 home made light bulb pipe cont. residue and 1 pill bottle containing a green leafy substance which field tested positive for marijuana.

Chelsea Gordon, Jacob Talley and Bryce Mitchell were placed under arrest for endeavoring to manufacture methamphetamine, possession of Drug paraphernalia, 3 counts of child endangerment and possession of a firearm while in the commission of a felony. Michael Hagar was placed under arrest for endeavoring to manufacture methamphetamine, possession of Drug paraphernalia, 3 counts of child endangerment, possession of a firearm (AFCF), possession of methamphetamine and possession of a precursor substance.

All subjects were transported to the Mannford police department including Hagar's 3 Juvenile sons that were taken into DHS custody while at the residence. The sons will be referred to as [REDACTED] 17yrs old, [REDACTED] 14yrs old and [REDACTED] 10 years old. Asst. DA Laura Farris was contacted and requested that the juveniles be drug tested. Doug Nichols administered the tests to the Juveniles. Nichols advised that 17 yr old [REDACTED] tested positive for meth and marijuana and 14 yr old [REDACTED] also tested positive for meth and marijuana. 10 yr old [REDACTED] stated that he had smoked marijuana earlier in the day and had smoked methamphetamine about a week ago. Your affiant and DHS case worker spoke with all three juveniles. All three stated that they knew their dad was a meth cook. All stated that they had helped him cook meth on several occasion. All stated that they helped by shaking the bottles for their dad. All said that they have smoked meth with their dad in the shed after a meth cook. They all advised that their father has given them baggies of methamphetamine on several occasions. 10 yr old [REDACTED] said "I help daddy the most by shaking the bottles and after we get done daddy puts the powder in a glass tube and holds a lighter under the tube while I suck on the tube".

Hagar was read his Miranda warning and agreed to speak with your affiant. Hagar stated that he has been cooking and using meth for about a year he said that he cooks about 4 to 5 times a week unless people bring him pseudo. Hagar said that he Burn his plastic containers but keeps other components and ingredients for future cook. Hagar said that he puts the components in a black plastic case and buries it near the shop until he needs it for the next cook. He advised that Chelsea Gordon, Jacob Talley and Bryce Mitchell brings pseudo pills, in return they receive finished product meth. Hagar said that all three above mentioned people has assisted him in 4 to 5 meth cooks throughout the year. Hagar stated that he purchased pseudo pills earlier in the day (2-23-2011) and done a cook with the pills later in the day. Hagar stated that he contacted the above mentioned people and advised them that he was almost finished with the cook. Hagar stated that all arrived after he finished the cook. Hagar said that Gordon and Mitchell shot up some of the

meth and Talley snorted a line of meth. Hagar said that he shot up some of the meth then left the residence to go get a package of cigarettes. Hagar said that when he seen your affiant pass him, then turn around on him on hwy 48, he placed a call to his residence. Hagar stated that he made contact with Talley and told him to have everyone put the lab and lab components in cases and take it in the woods behind the shop. Hagar advised that he has let his juvenile sons help him cook meth on several occasions; he said that he only lets them shake the bottles. Hagar said that he has smoked meth with his sons and has given them baggies of finished product meth. A criminal check of Hagar shows that he pled guilty to felon count robbery with a dangerous weapon in 1989 and pled guilty to felony possession of CDS and paraphernalia in 2004. Hagar, Gordon, Mitchell and Talley were all transported to the Creek County jail on the above stated charges.

The above stated case was conducted in Creek County.
