PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

Comes now the undersigned Affiant Timothy W. Turner, an Investigator with the District 18 Drug and Violent Crimes Task Force, Haskell County, and states under oath or affirmation that the following information is correct to the best of Affiant's knowledge and belief.

On July 11, 2011 at about 7:45 PM I was contacted by Haskell County Sheriff Brian Hale. Hale advised me there had been a shooting at 20159 East Perry Road, Stilger, Oklahoma 74462, which is located in rural Haskell County. Hale asked me for assistance with the shooting. Hale advised me that there was one victim deceased and the other victim was being transported to the Haskell County Hospital. Hale advised me that he and Haskell County Deputy Buntin had entered the residence and Buntin advised that he noticed there was a deceased white male inside the residence and Buntin also noticed that the deceased white male appeared to have a gun shot wound. Hale advised me he had noticed what appeared to be two gun shot holes in the bedroom door where the deceased white male was.

I was advised that the female victim lying in the garden outside of the residence also appeared to have a gun shot wound to the head. This victim was transported to the Haskell County Hospital then transported by life flight to a Tulsa Hospital.

Once at the Haskell County Sheriffs Office I was advised that the deceased male was a Herbert Moore D/O/B 12-06-1931 and the female victim was Vickie Moore D/O/B 04-20-1959.

I was also advised that Oklahoma Highway Patrol Trooper Nathan Neill was advised by Vickie Moore in the ambulance at the Haskell County Hospital while waiting to be transported by life flight she was shot by Joshua Allan Bowen.

Bowen was arrested by Haskell County Deputy Mike Buntin at the residence where the shooting had taken place. Bowen was transported to the Haskell County Jail where he was booked into jail.

I was then contacted by Haskell County Jail Administrator Casey Borders and advised Bowen wanted to speak with me.

On July 11, 2011 at about 10:42 PM, I went to the Haskell County Sheriffs Office. Once at the Haskell County Sheriff's Office I spoke with Joshua Allan Bowen D/O/B 02-05-1993. I read Bowen the Miranda Warning from a form provided by the District 18 Drug and Violent Crimes Task Force. Bowen appeared to understand his Miranda Warning. Bowen agreed to talk to me and signed and initialed the Miranda Warning Form. Bowen advised me that he had shot and killed his step-dad Herbert Moore and then shot his mother Vickie Moore in the garden. Bowen advised he couldn't finish her. Bowen told me he had shot his step-dad several times and his mother just once. Bowen advised me once he had shot his step-dad he went outside to the garden and shot his mother because he was scared and knew he was in trouble. Bowen advised that once he shot his step-dad and mother he went back into the residence and put the gun in the safe. Bowen advised that the key to the safe was still in his shorts that he was wearing when he was booked into jail. Bowen advised he shot his step-dad until he was dead so he wouldn't suffer. Bowen advised he thought about shooting his mother one more time but just couldn't do it.

Based on the above information, the undersigned prays that this Honorable Court issue a finding of fact that probable cause exists to believe that the **FELONY** crime of

1. Title 21 OS § 701.7 Murder in the First Degree
2. Title 21 OS § 652 Shooting with intent to Kill

has been committed and there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant committed said crimes.
