TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

This matter comes for hearing on the ____ day of October, 2012. The court has reviewed the information contained in the Application for a Temporary restraining order from the State Board of Dentistry. The court has further received testimony to the same from officials, certified law enforcement officers and a licensed dentist(s) on behalf of the Board. The Plaintiff has moved for a Temporary Restraining Order to enjoin the Defendants from providing teeth whitening treatments at the Tulsa State Fairgrounds or in Tulsa County without holding a valid dental license, pending a hearing on Plaintiff's Application for a Permanent Restraining Order for the same.

The Court finds that it clearly appears from the Plaintiff's evidence and testimony that the activities as witnessed by investigators from the State of Oklahoma Board of Dentistry as described in the application constitute the practice of dentistry by unlicensed individuals as described by state statute in 59 O.S. § 328.19(A)(1), 59 O.S. § 328.19(A)(2), 59 O.S. § 328.19(A)(3), 59 O.S. § 328.19(A)(4) and 59 O.S. § 328.19(A)(11) and are classified as felonies by Oklahoma law. Allowing the Defendants to continue teeth whitening

“treatments/procedures/services” will further endanger the health and safety of the persons seeking treatment from untrained and unlicensed individuals operating in this manner. The Court finds that under these circumstances that a Temporary Restraining Order should be granted without notice to prevent further irreparable injury to the Plaintiff and the safety and welfare of citizens in the interim before the Court is able to hear the Application for Permanent Injunction.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendants, Euroshine USA, Ingo Van Styn and Henry Johnson., their agents, servants and all persons acting by and through their authority or in concert with them, are restrained from advertising and providing teeth whitening treatments at the State Fair of Tulsa or in Tulsa County without a valid State of Oklahoma dental license until _____ at _____ o'clock, __.m., 2012 at which time the Defendants will be given an opportunity to show cause why the foregoing Restraining Order should not be made a Permanent Injunction, in the Courtroom of the Undersigned Judge.
