
BILL OF PARTICULARS

I, the undersigned District Attorney of the 14th Judicial District, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, do upon my official oath give this Court and the Defendant, Joel Rosales Pina, to know and be informed that two counts of Murder in the First Degree as charged in the information were committed by the said Joel Rosales Pina, named therein and said Defendant should be punished by Death due to and as a result of the following Aggravating Circumstances, to wit:

1. The Defendant, Joel Rosales Pina was previously convicted of a felony involving the use or threat of violence to the person; 21 O.S. Sec. 701.12(1).
2. The Defendant, Joel Rosales Pina knowingly created a great risk of death to more than one person; 21 O.S. Sec. 701.12(2).
3. The Defendant, Joel Rosales Pina committed the murder for remuneration or the promise of remuneration or employed another to commit the murder for remuneration or the promise of remuneration; 21 O.S. 701.12 (3).
4. The existence of a probability that the defendant would commit criminal acts of violence that would constitute a continuing threat to society; 21 O.S. 701.12 (7)



- 2. The existence of a probability that the defendant would commit criminal acts of violence that would constitute a continuing threat to society. 21 O.S. §701.12(7)**


