Arrests per 1,000 Students	Total = 88 or 2.2 per 1,000
Part 1 Crime Incidents per 1,000 Students	Total = 44 or 1.1 per 1,000
Bus Accidents per 100,000 Miles	Total = 77 or 1.9 per 100,000
Number of Suspensions of Students for Assault on School Employees	Total = 288 or 75 fewer assaults

Percent of Safe School Plans Submitted on Time	90.9% - 70 out of possible 77
Percent of Emergency Drills that Identified a Problem	1.4% - 7 out of 509 drill reports
Bullying / Harassment Incidents per 1,000 Students	Total = 2,124 or 53.1 per 1,000

Number of Suspensions per 1,000 Students	Total = 8,538 or 219 per 1,000

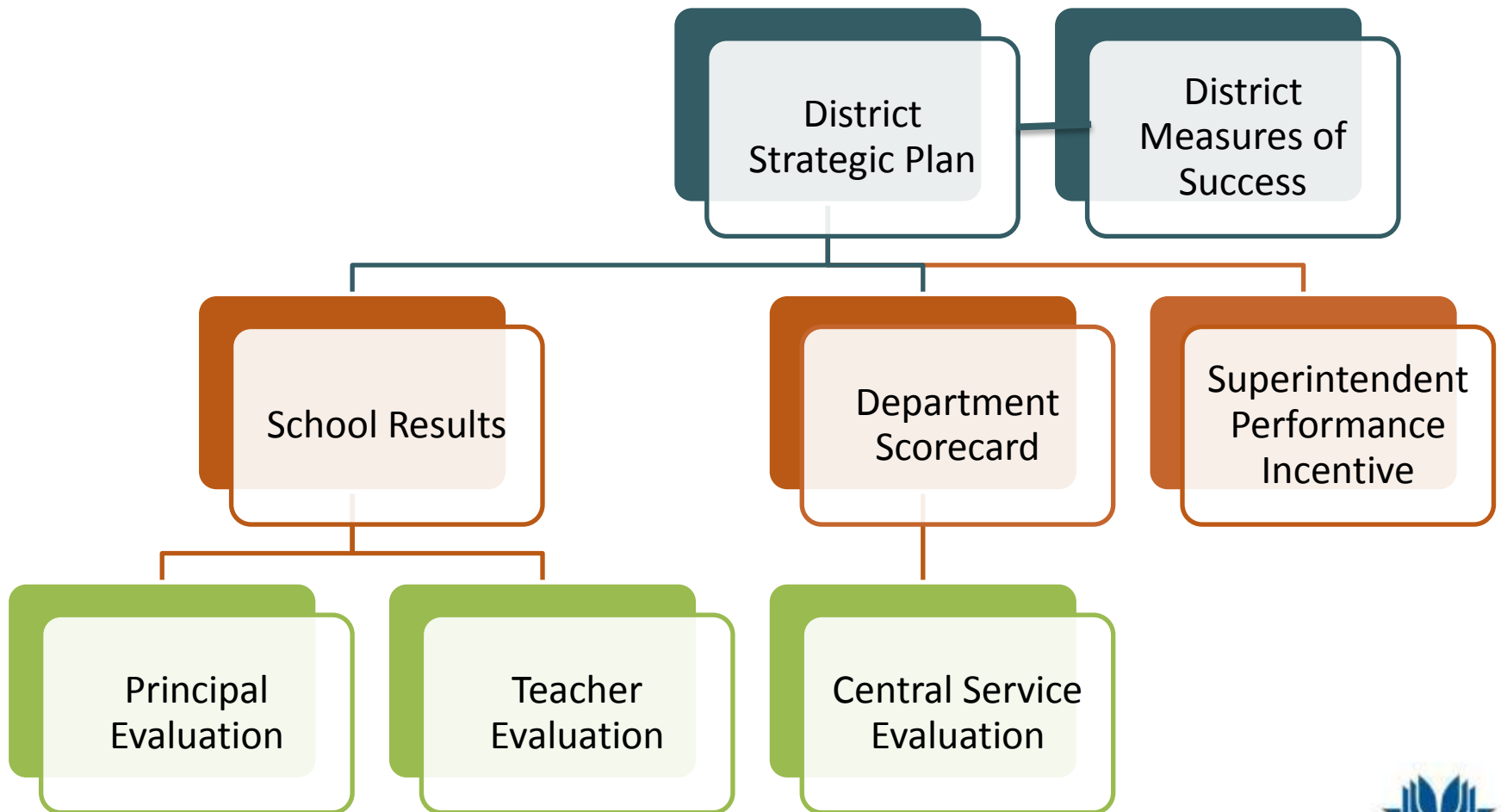

Student Attendance Rate API - District Wide	92.5%
Pre-K thru 6 = 94.2%	
7 th and 8 th = 91.6%	
9 th thru 12 th = 87.4%	
Average Time to Complete Facilities / Maintenance Work Orders	7.9 Days

Summary

- **Safe and Secure Schools**
 - Arrests of students for criminal violations has significantly decreased as has assaults against school staff.
 - Transportation records indicate an excellent safety record.
 - In consideration of the most recent series of emergency situations at schools across the nation, the importance of effective drills cannot be understated. We should strive for 100% compliance in each of the respective categories related to emergency drills and Safe School Plans.
 - The data indicates that a focus on middle schools has the highest potential for reducing suspensions, bullying and harassment concerns as those sites show a disproportionate number of events compared to population.
