INTERVIEW OF Witness

On March 27, 2010, at 1311 hours, I interviewed Victor David in Interview Room #2 at the Garland County Sheriff's Department. Sgt. Joel Ware was present during the interview. Prior to the interview, I read David his Miranda Rights using the standard form. He initialed and signed that he understood them. The following is his statement:

VP I've know Sam Conway, Ernest Conway, Detric Conway, Jeremy Pickney, and Marvin Stringer for several years. Jeremy Gentry was also a friend of mine.

On the night Marvin was killed, Sam Conway talked to me at PeeWee's house on Wood Street. Sam told me that Jeremy Gentry had tried to steal Ernest Conway's car and rims. Sam said that Ernest had called and told him about it and that Detric had told them they were going to go rob Jeremy Gentry.

Sam Conway told me that him, Detric Conway, Ernest Conway, Jeremy Pickney, Marvin Stringer and Anthony Cornilious all went out to Jeremy Gentry's house. Sam told me that him, Jeremy, and Marvin were running around stealing rims, TVs, drugs, and other stuff.

Sam told me that he went back inside the trailer and Detric was looking at him. Sam said that it all went crazy when my brother Detric started shooting people. Sam said that after Detric shot the girl, Ernest went over to her, said that she was still alive, and shot her again. Sam said that they didn't even know about the old man next door, but that Detric found him and shot him.

Sam said that Detric told him to go and get some gas and to pile up the bodies and burn them. Sam that he got some gas and poured it around the house and around the bodies. He said that Detric got mad, pointed the gun at him, and asked why he didn't pour the gas on the bodies. He said that Detric said that if he would have poured it on the bodies, it would have burned the bodies up first.

Sam told me that Detric was carrying a .380 pistol that night and Ernest had a ^{VP22}38. Sam had the guns that night on Wood Street and was trying to sell them. He and Jeremy later left with the guns and I don't know what they did with them.

Sam told me that on the way back from Jeremy Gentry's, Detric told all of them that if they talked about this, he would kill them, brothers or not. VD

Sam Conway and Jeremy Gentry were supposed to be at the hotel the Marvin was killed. They never went over there. Marvin had called me the day he was killed, telling me that he loved us and that he wasn't gonna go out like no bitch. Anthony told me that Marvin thought that Detric was going to come kill him at the motel. I think that's why Marvin started shooting when the police got there.

Detric has never talked to me directly about any of this. But Ernest has. In fact, Ernest told me last night that he and Detric were the main ones and he didn't like it that his brother (Sam) was locked up for the murders. VJ
