The Important Role Church Response plays in Fighting Hunger in our Community

- Distributes approximately 20,000 bags of food a year to those in need in our community.
- Donated bread, fruits and vegetables are available daily in our lobby for anyone who needs them.
- One-half of all the food distributed goes to feed children
- One fifth goes to feed the elderly on a fixed income
- Most of the adults who receive food are working poor
- The biggest growth in need is from families who have been laid off or who have lost their job in the last year.



- Distributed over 12 million pounds of food to 500 non-profit agencies statewide with Western South Dakota distributing over 3 million pounds to 180 non-profit agencies.
- Distributed 1.5 million pounds of food to families in need from our Emergency Pantries statewide with Western South Dakota distributing 782,000 pounds.
- Operate the Backpack Program which provides over 5,000 at risk school children a food package each weekend statewide with Western South Dakota providing 1,728 food packages.
- Partner with Habitat for Humanity to provide food and personal items for the family when they move in.
- Are part of the Disaster Response team that provides both food and staff members to assist when a disaster strikes locally and around the country.
