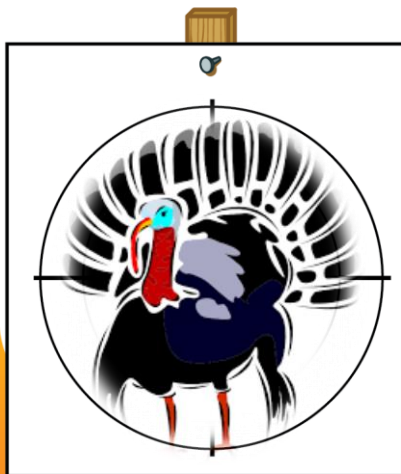


# Hunting with Wildfire

## Safety in Mind

- ☀ When shooting close to the ground, be sure there is no dry grass or tinder in front of your muzzle.
- ☀ If fire danger is high, consider shooting at an established outdoor or indoor range.
- ☀ Keep water nearby when welding on stands.
- ☀ Be aware that steel core ammo can cause sparks when striking a rock, and potentially start a wildfire.
- ☀ Exploding targets and tracer ammunition create an explosion that can catch the dry vegetation on fire.
- ☀ Don't shoot trash that was illegally dumped, like old TVs and couches. They are a dangerous fire hazards when shot.
- ☀ Avoid parking on dry grass.
