COUNT II

Thomas Hardy, on or about January 23, 2011, did knowingly,
while armed with a deadly weapon, that is: a gun, take from the
person or presence of [REDACTED] property, that is: U.S.
currency belonging to the Dollar General store, by putting

[REDACTED] in fear or by using or threatening the use of force on [REDACTED]

COUNT III

Thomas Hardy, being a serious violent felon, that is: having been convicted of Burglary in Marion County Superior Court, Criminal Division Room 6 under cause number CR83-075F on July 29, 1983, did on or about January 23, 2011, knowingly or intentionally possess a firearm, that is: a gun;


all of which is contrary to statute and against the peace and dignity of the State of Indiana.
