TAKE HIM/HER FORTHWITH TO BE BOOKED AND CHARGED IN ACCORDANCE



BEFORE ME, the undersigned Judge of MAGISTRATE Court, Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, personally came and appeared: WALTER EDMOND #954, employed by the New Orleans Police Department, 715 South Broad Street, New Orleans, Louisiana WHO, after first being duly sworn by me, deposed and stated that a warrant of arrest should issue ordering the arrest of: CAIN, EURIC (B/M 05/12/1994 who, on the 20TH day of NOVEMBER, 2015, in the Parish of Orleans, State of Louisiana, did commit the crime of ATTEMPT FIRST DEGREE MURDER, ARMED ROBBERY WITH A FIREARM, SECOND DEGREE KIDNAPPING, ATTEMPT ARMED ROBBERY WITH A FIREARM as defined in the Louisiana Revised Statute 14(27)30, 14:64.3, 14:44.1, 14:(27)64.3 The facts and circumstances given to support the issuance of this warrant are:

ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2015 SIXTH DISTRICT OFFICERS RESPONDED TO A SIGNAL 34S, AGGRAVATED BATTERY BY SHOOTING WHICH OCCURRED IN THE 1000 BLOCK OF ST. MARY STREET. ONCE ON SCENE OFFICERS OBSERVED A MALE VICTIM WHO SUSTAINED A SINGLE GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE STOMACH. OFFICERS ALSO CAME IN CONTACT WITH A FEMALE VICTIM WHO INFORMED THEM THAT SHE HAD BEEN ROBBED OF HER PURSE. THE MALE VICTIM WAS TRANSPORTED TO UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL IN CRITICAL CONDITION.

DURING THE COURSE OF THE INVESTIGATION DET. EDMOND OBTAINED SURVEILLANCE FOOTAGE OF THE INCIDENT. DET. EDMOND OBSERVED ON THE SURVEILLANCE FOOTAGE THE FEMALE VICTIM WALKING DOWN MAGAZINE STREET CROSSING ST. MARY STREET AND FALLING TO THE GROUND. ABOUT THE SAME TIME THE FEMALE VICTIM FALLS TO THE GROUND AN UNKNOWN BLACK MALE PARKS A GREY FORD EXPEDITION ON ST. MARY STREET. THE


UNKNOWN MALE WALKS UP TO THE FEMALE VICTIM AND ATTEMPTS TO HELP HER UP. THE FEMALE VICTIM RESISTS THE ASSISTANCE OF THE UNKNOWN BLACK MALE SEVERAL TIMES BEFORE THE BLACK MALE IS OBSERVED ON VIDEO PUSHING THE FEMALE VICTIM TO THE GROUND, RIPPING HER PURSE AWAY FROM HER, AND THEN CARRYING HER TO HIS VEHICLE. THE UNKNOWN BLACK MALE TRIES TO OPEN HIS VEHICLE DOOR AND THE FEMALE VICTIM RESISTS AGAIN. THE UNKNOWN BLACK MALE IS OBSERVED GETTING INTO HIS VEHICLE WITH THE FEMALE VICTIM'S PURSE.


THE MALE VICTIM APPROACHES THE BLACK MALE AT WHICH TIME THE UNKNOWN BLACK MALE EXITS HIS VEHICLE POINTING A LARGE FIREARM AT THE MALE VICTIM. THE UNKNOWN BLACK MALE DEMANDS MONEY FROM THE MALE VICTIM WHILE POINTING THE GUN AT HIM. THE MALE VICTIM INFORMS THE SUBJECT THAT HE DOES NOT HAVE ANY MONEY. THE UNKNOWN BLACK MALE THEN SHOOTS THE MALE VICTIM IN THE STOMACH. THE UNKNOWN BLACK MALE THEN ATTEMPTS TO SHOOT THE MALE VICTIM IN THE HEAD SEVERAL TIMES BUT THE FIREARM JAMS. THE UNKNOWN BLACK MALES RE-ENTERS THE GREY VEHICLE AND FLEES THE SCENE.

ON NOVEMBER 21, 2015 DETECTIVES OBSERVED A GREY FORD EXPEDITION VEHICLE PARKED IN A PARKING LOT WITHIN CENTRAL CITY. DETECTIVES OBSERVED THAT VEHICLE WAS THE EXACT SAME VEHICLE SEEN IN THE SURVEILLANCE FOOTAGE FROM THE INCIDENT ON ST. MARY ST. DETECTIVES CONDUCTED A KNOCK AND TALK WITH THE KNOWN WITNESS WHO LIVED IN THE AREA. THE KNOWN WITNESS INFORMED DETECTIVES THAT THE VEHICLE WAS LOANED TO A SUBJECT KNOWN AS "YOUNGIN". THE KNOWN WITNESS STATED THAT HE KNEW THE NAME OF "YOUNGIN" TO BE "EURIC". DET. EDMOND IMMEDIATELY KNEW OF A SUBJECT FROM THE AREA WITH THE NAME OF "EURIC". THE KNOWN WITNESS STATED THAT THE SUBJECT "EURIC" HAD THE GREY EXPEDITION. THE KNOWN WITNESS STATED THAT THE SUBJECT "EURIC" DID NOT RETURN THE VEHICLE UNTIL FRIDAY EVENING. THE KNOWN WITNESS STATED THAT HE HAD BEEN KNOWING THE SUBJECT "EURIC" FOR SEVERAL YEARS.

DET. EDMOND RELOCATED TO THE STATION AND PRINTED A SINGLE PHOTOGRAPH OF THE SUBJECT WHO WAS KNOWN TO DET. EDMOND. THE SUBJECT WAS EURIC CAIN (B/M 5/12/1994). DET. EDMOND RELOCATED BACK TO THE KNOWN WITNESS AND SHOWED THE KNOWN WITNESS THE PHOTOGRAPH WHICH HE POSITIVELY IDENTIFIED. DETECTIVES SHOWED THE KNOWN WITNESS THE VIDEO DEPICTED WHEN THE CRIME OCCURRED. THE KNOWN WITNESS IMMEDIATELY IDENTIFIED THE SUBJECT IN THE VIDEO AS THE SUBJECT "EURIC" WHO HAD THE VEHICLE ON THE MORNING OF NOVEMBER 20, 2015.
